

PRESS RELEASE

The Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has decided to extend the time limit for filing ITR-V forms relating to income-tax returns for A.Y. 2010-11 filed electronically (without digital signature) on or after 1st April, 2010. These ITR-V forms can now be filed upto 31st July, 2011 or within a period of 120 days from the date of uploading of the electronic return data, whichever is later.

2. The relaxation has been made since there are still a large number of electronic returns relating to A.Y. 2010-11 which had been filed on or before the due date but for which the ITR-V forms have not yet been received at the Centralised Processing Centre (CPC), Bangalore. These taxpayers are being given a final opportunity to send ITR-V forms to the CPC, Bangalore by the date mentioned in para 1 above.

3. The ITR-V forms should be sent by ordinary post or speed post to Post Bag No.1, Electronic City Post Office, Bangalore – 560100 (Karnataka).
